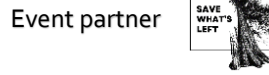
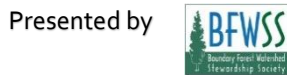

With the massive loss of primary (never logged) forest due to industrial forestry, communities are at risk. We're facing more drought, fire, and floods. The new Forest Act proposal is intended to stop the land from becoming any more degraded from industrial forestry than it already is.
